Dear Friends, Partners, and Supporters,

The Wyoming Stock Growers Land Trust team strives to conserve Wyoming's agricultural lands, keeping the open spaces and working lands that shape our state intact for today and future generations. The pages of this Annual Report are a chance for you – landowners, donors, volunteers, and partners – to reflect on this impact and read about what is next for the organization.

In fiscal year 2022 we had the opportunity to work with three families to conserve three properties, protecting 3,645 acres in Sublette County, bringing our total acreage to 287,792 acres. These acres of conservation easements are more than just a number, they represent families committed to conserving agriculture, protecting important wildlife habitats, preserving agricultural lands and legacies, providing clean water, and contributing to rural economies.

Of course, the work is not done. For this impact to be recognized for generations to come, we must keep working to meet the needs of landowners and the land. We are actively working on 19 projects across almost 80,000 acres. To meet demand, we are increasing our staff to six full-time employees and providing more opportunities for student interns to participate in our efforts.

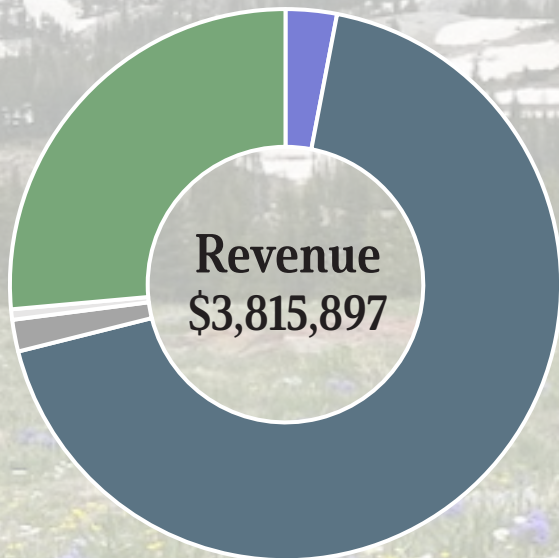

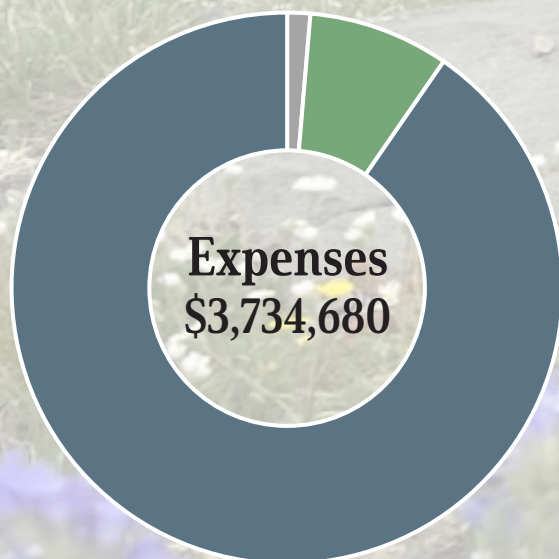
