A note from our Executive Director

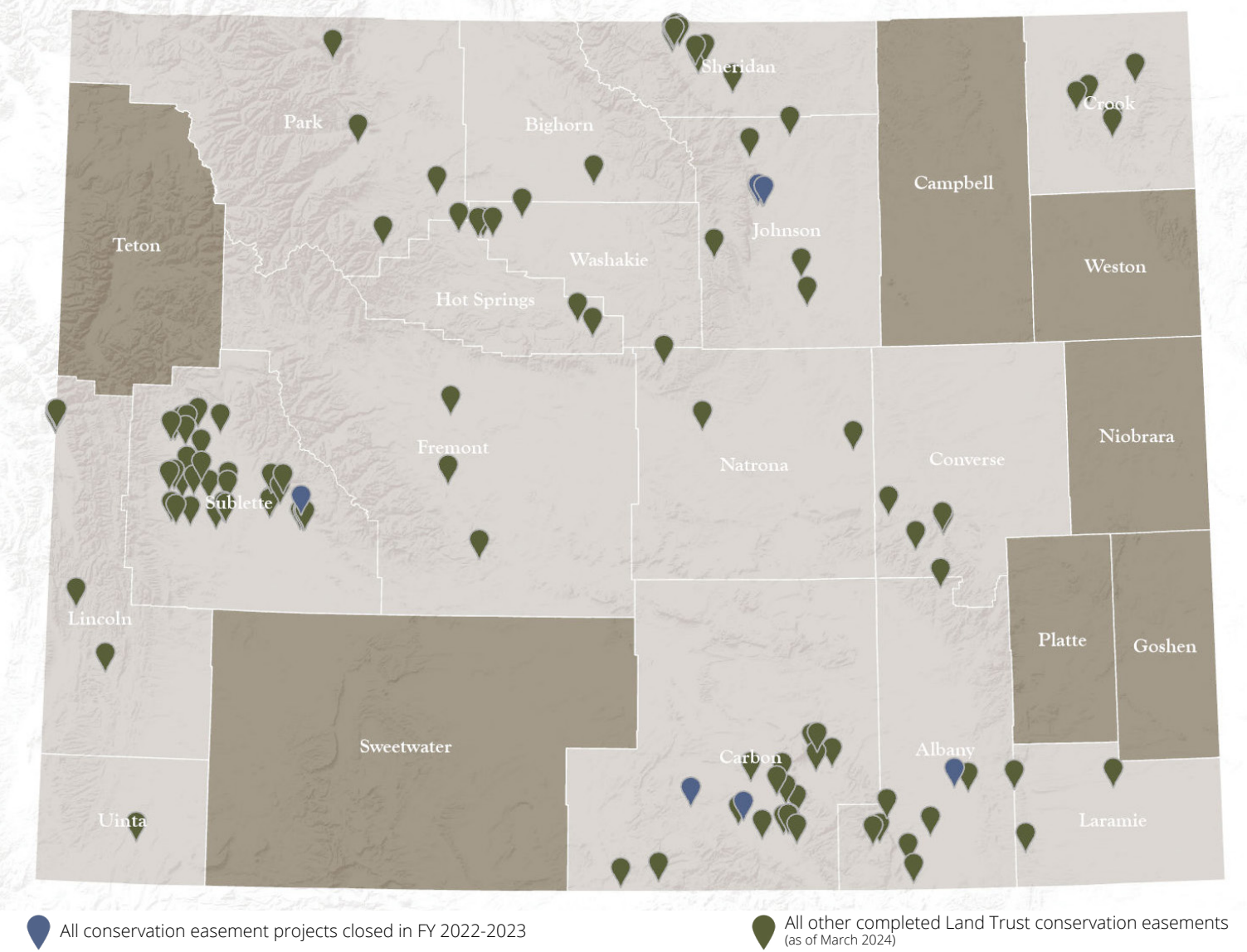
Each conservation easement the Wyoming Stock Growers Land Trust works on is unique, providing important values that future generations will rely on and appreciate.

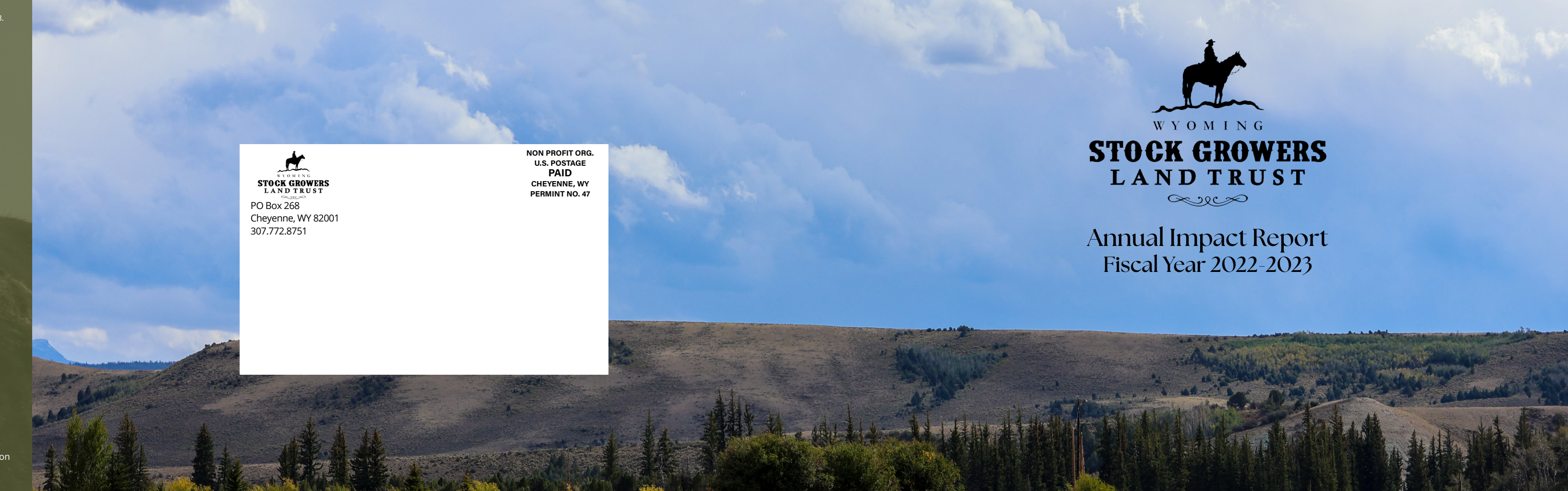
